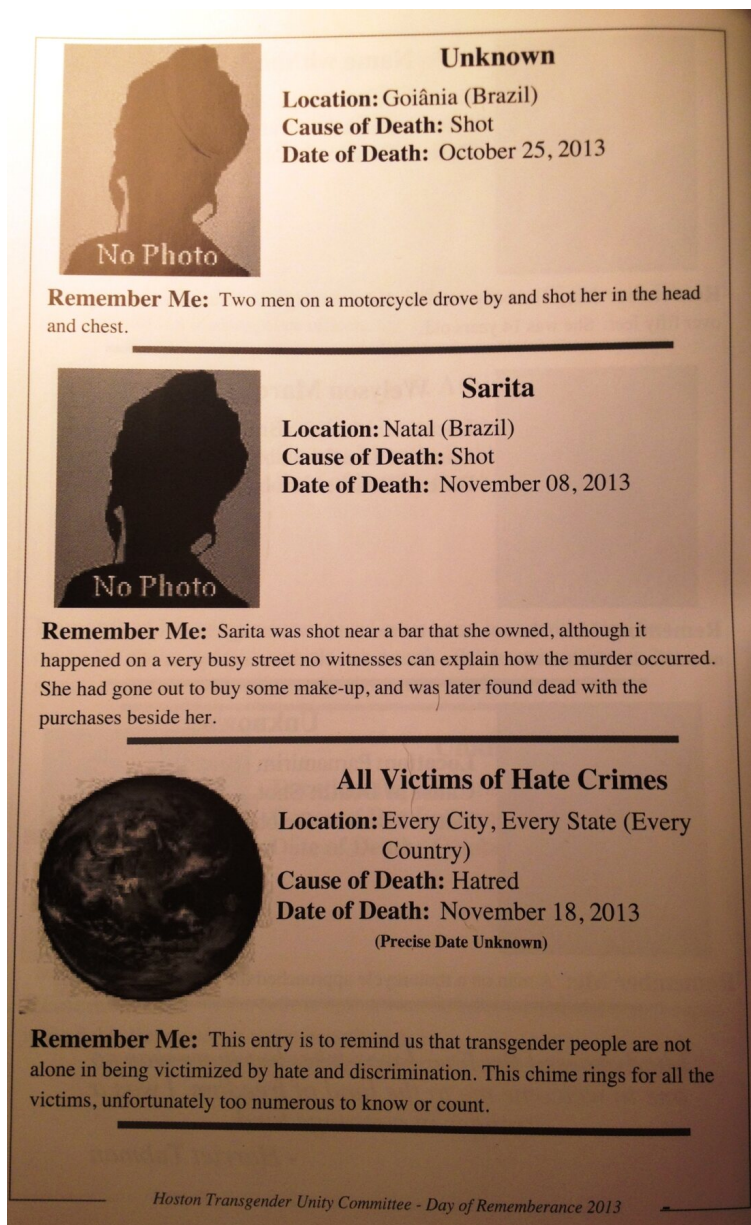


Figure 1. The last page of the Houston and San Antonio TDOR booklet
