The Houston Equal Rights Ordinance protects 15 separate classes. They are:

- Sex
- Race

- Color
- Ethnicity
- National Origin
- Age
- Familial Status
- Marital Status
- Military Status
- Religion
- Disability
- Sexual Orientation
- Genetic Information
- Gender Identity
- Pregnancy
